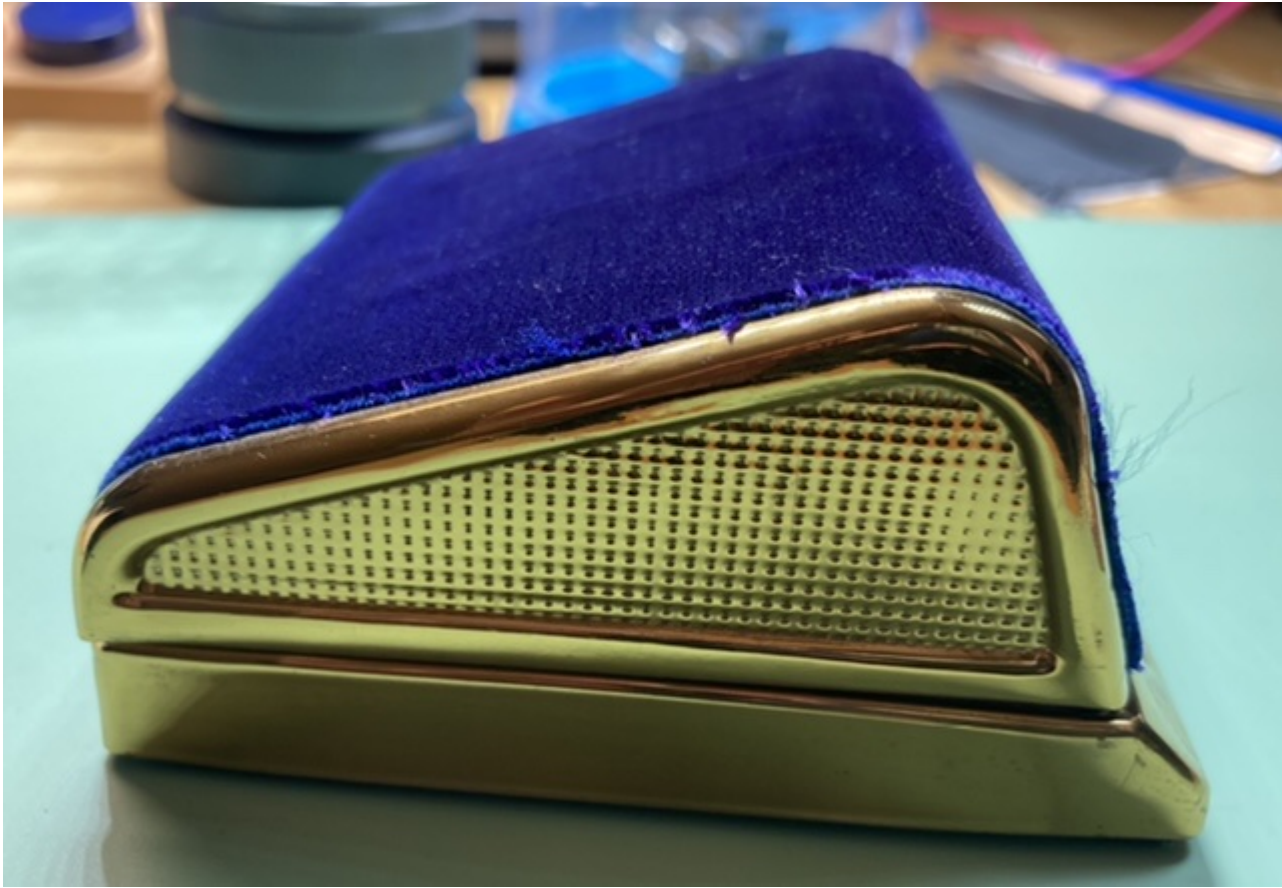

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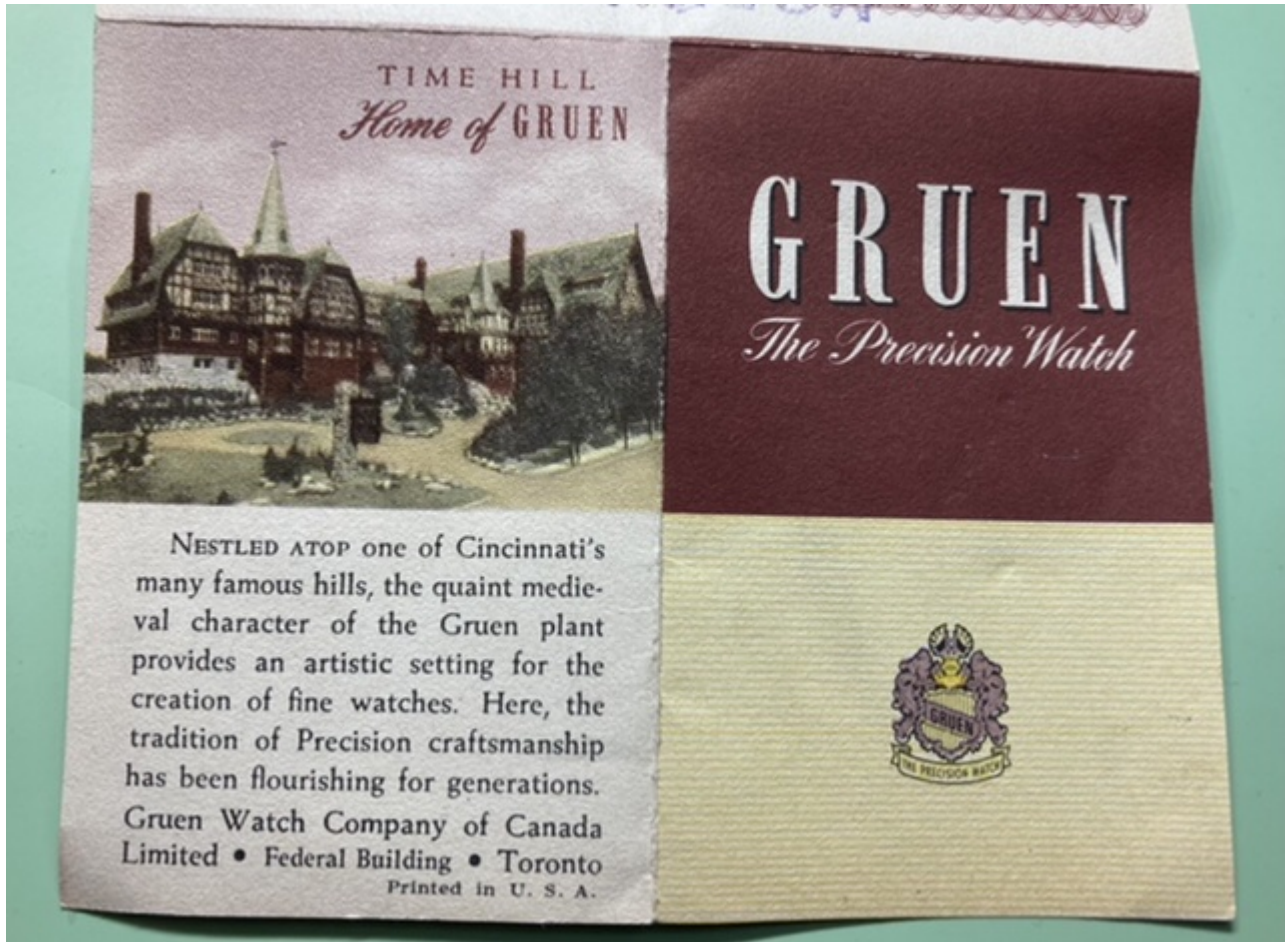

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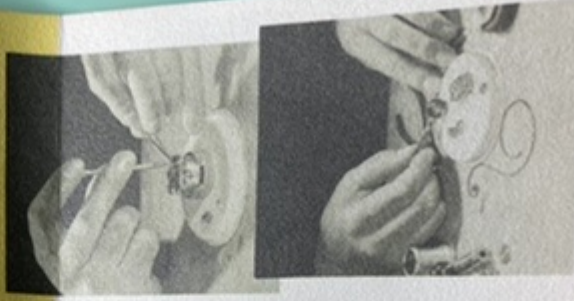


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NATURALLY, you will want to give your Gruen the kind of care a fine watch deserves. These few rules will guide you in its care.

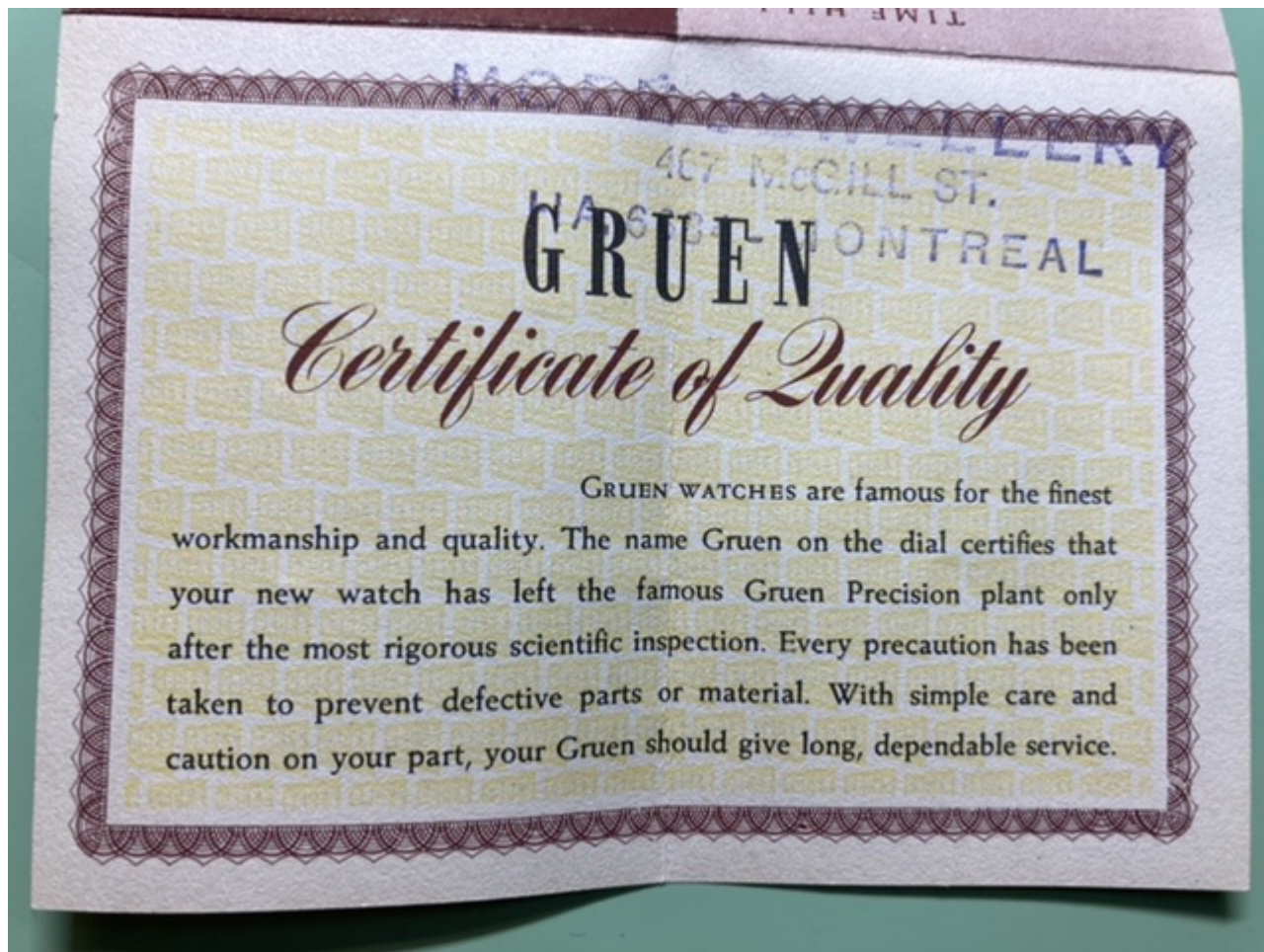
